Deer Creek Coyote Hunting

General Rules

1. Coyote hunting will be open to all full members that are currently on the qualified Deer Hunters list.
 2. All hunters are responsible for knowing all State and Federal laws and having all applicable licenses and stamps in their possession.
 3. Coyote hunting can only be done from a tree stand. All hunters must sign in and out of the Coyote Hunting book located in the gatehouse. Exception: any legal deer hunter already signed in to deer hunt may take coyote during their hunt without signing into the Coyote Hunting book, but must report any kill in the Deer Hunters sign-in book.
 4. Zones 1–7 will be open to Archery during legal Deer Archery Season and hours. During Deer Firearm/Muzzleloader seasons, State laws apply.
 5. After Deer season ends, only Zones 3 (west of the creek only), 4, and 5 may be used. Hunting at this time is permitted 24 hours a day through the end of February. March 1st through the 15th is nighttime only ($\frac{1}{2}$ hr. before sunset to $\frac{1}{2}$ hr. after sunrise).
 6. The doubles are considered the primary stand for coyote hunting; however, any stand still up in the proper areas is useable. A safety harness is required at all times. Hunters participating in Coyote Hunting will be responsible for removal of the doubles in these areas.
 7. After Deer season ends, acceptable coyote hunting methods at Deer Creek are Shotgun, Muzzleloader, and Archery only.
 8. Trapping is now allowed in Zones 1 and 2 after Deer season ends through March 15th. All traps must be marked with a visible flag.
 9. The Deer Creek Board has final say on all rules and activities at Deer Creek and may make amendments as deemed necessary.
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
